ENGINE THERMOSTATS

MODELS:

ALL MODELS

It is of paramount importance to ensure that the correct thermostat as specified for any particular model is used whenever replacement is required.

This is particularly important on the Triumph TR7, inasmuch as this model uses a double-acting type of thermostat which in the 'OPEN' position blanks off the bypass, thereby increasing the water flow. If this type of thermostat is not used on this engine, overheating may occur.
