EMERGENCY STARTING BY THE USE OF EXTERNAL POWER EQUIPMENT

ALL MODELS

Due to the increasing number of electronic units now used on British Leyland vehicles, it has been found that serious damage can occur to those components by the use of external emergency starting equipment.

If the battery in the vehicle is in a low state of charge, it should be replaced with a new one and under no circumstances should any attempt be made to jump start from another vehicle or alternatively emergency equipment. It is extremely important that this information is circulated to all dealer personnel.
