When removing and replacing cylinder head bolts it is essential to clean the bolt threads immediately after removal with 3M solvent #2. This will prevent the hardening of the sealer/lubricant used on previous assembly.

When replacing the bolts, the threads must be coated with 3M sealer/lubricant EC776. Damage to the aluminum cylinder block and a false torque reading could occur if the sealer/lubricant is not used.
